

Hill International Trucks A26 Engine

Beyond its incredible lifespan, the new 12.4-liter engine boasts an impressive line of specs:

- Up to 475 Horsepower
- 1,450 lb.-ft of torque
- 600-700 lbs. Lighter than traditional 15L big bore engines
- Improved oil pressure to increase oil service intervals up to 70,000 miles
- 50% reduction in parasitic loss to the water pump



Perhaps the most impressive aspect of the A26 is its significant weight-reduction. Weighing in 55 lbs. lighter than its predecessor and allowing for the reduction of 200 lbs. of vehicle-mounted component weight, the A26 rides like a featherweight but punches like a heavyweight champ, all with less fuel consumption and emissions.

Though just released in late February, 2017, the A26 is no greenhorn. International[®] has logged millions of real-world test miles in some of the most difficult roads on the continent, including at extreme cold and high elevation. Plus, the A26 includes the industry's best warranty with two years, unlimited miles.
