International Uptime Assurance Program



International has been going through a re branding phase that has included new models and components. Earlier this year, International introduced the all new A26 engine, which is a powerful 12.4-liter engine designed to provide industry-leading uptime, durability, and reliability. In August, International demonstrated their confidence with the engine by providing the International A26 Customer Uptime Assistance Program.

The International A26 Customer Uptime Assistance program provides customers a \$250 International Advantage Card when they experience a warrantable failure on an A26 engine within its two-year warranty and experience 48 hours or more of downtime from the time the problem was diagnosed. The Advantage Card is good for future parts and service purchases at an International dealership. A customer may be eligible for a maximum of 8 cards, worth up to \$2,000 per vehicle.



International LT and RH series trucks equipped with the A26 engine and that are enrolled in OnCommand Connection Advanced Remote Diagnostics or OnCommand Connection Telematics are eligible for the program. The A26 engine has been designed to improve downtime, by increasing service intervals that keep the truck on the road longer. The increased service interval is achieved through oil, after treatment, and best-in-class coolant service intervals in the A26 engine at eight years, 15,000 hours, and 1.2 million miles. The A26 engine was derived from the proven MAN D26 engine crankcase and produces 450hp and 1,750 lb. Ft. of torque and is 600-700 lbs lighter than a traditional 15L big bore engine.
